Three Options for an Atheist

- 1) The atheist knows that God exists but suppresses and ignores it (Romans 1:21a)
- 2) The atheist has entirely darkened their hearts towards a relationship with God altogether (Romans 1:21b)
 - 3) The atheist has exchanged the truth of God for a lie that there is no God (Romans 1:25)


