THE PERSENERANCE OF THE SAINTS

³ We ought always to thank God for you, brothers and sisters, and rightly so, because your faith is growing more and more, and the love all of you have for one another is increasing.

⁴Therefore, among God's churches we boast about your perseverance and faith in all the persecutions and trials you are enduring. ⁵ All this is evidence that God's judgment is right, and as a result you will be

counted worthy of the kingdom of God, for which you are suffering. ⁶ God is just: He will pay back trouble to those who trouble you ⁷ and give relief to you who are troubled, and to us as well.

This will happen when the Lord Jesus is revealed from heaven in blazing fire with his powerful angels. 8 He will punish those who do not know God and do not obey the gospel of our Lord Jesus.

⁹They will be punished with everlasting destruction and shut out from the presence of the Lord and from the glory of his might 10 on the day he comes to be glorified in his holy people and to be marveled at

among all those who have believed. This includes you, because you believed our testimony to you.

A) GROWIN GROWIN

³ We ought always to thank God for you, brothers and sisters, and rightly so, because your faith is growing more and more.

Faith is only a starting point with God.

18 Against all hope, Abraham in hope believed and so became the father of many nations, just as it had been said to him, "So shall your offspring be." 19 Without weakening in his faith,

he faced the fact that his body was as good as dead—since he was about a hundred years old—and that Sarah's womb was also dead. 20 Yet he did not waver through unbelief regarding the promise of God,

but was strengthened in his faith and gave glory to God, ²¹ being fully persuaded that God had power to do what he had promised.

Faith grows only from being fully persuaded that God will do what He said He would do.

Christians and churches that are not growing in faith are spiritually dying.

Vital means alive, vibrant, essential, relevant and growing.

B) INCREASE INICIES

³ We ought always to thank God for you, brothers and sisters, and rightly so, because... the love all of you have for one another is increasing.

¹² May the Lord make your love increase and overflow for each other and for everyone else, just as ours does for you.

⁹ Now about your love for one another we do not need to write to you, for you yourselves have been taught by God to love each other.

C) ENDURE PERSECUTION

⁴Therefore, among God's churches we boast about your perseverance and faith in all the persecutions and trials you are enduring.

² Consider it pure joy, my brothers and sisters, whenever you face trials of many kinds, ³ because you know that the testing of your faith produces perseverance.

JAMES 1:2-4

⁴ Let perseverance finish its work so that you may be mature and complete, not lacking anything.

JAMES 1:2-4

We must learn to distinguish between testing which is God-approved and temptation is Satan-approved.

No one can become mature in the faith without developing perseverance. This grit and resilience will ensure that our faith will stand the test of time.

The Apostle Paul's primary boast was not in himself, but in Christ and his secondary boast was in believers who persevered.

¹⁰ Brothers and sisters, as an example of patience in the face of suffering, take the prophets who spoke in the name of the Lord. ¹¹ As you know, we count as blessed those who have persevered.

JAMES 5:10-11

You have heard of Job's perseverance and have seen what the Lord finally brought about. The Lord is full of compassion and mercy.

There is a blessing for those who persevere.

¹⁰ Blessed are those who are persecuted because of righteousness, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven. 11 "Blessed are you when people insult you, persecute you and falsely say all

kinds of evil against you because of me. 12 Rejoice and be glad, because great is your reward in heaven, for in the same way they persecuted the prophets who were before you.

To persevere means to endure now with our eyes set on what is to come.

WHO GOD IS

A) GODISJUSII

⁵ All this is evidence that God's judgment is right, and as a result you will be counted worthy of the kingdom of God, for which you are suffering.

⁶ God is just: He will pay back trouble to those who trouble you ⁷ and give relief to you who are troubled, and to us as well.

The negative connotation of judgement is eternal damnation, but the positive connotation of judgement is wise decision-making.

B) GODWILL PUNISH

This will happen when the Lord Jesus is revealed from heaven in blazing fire with his powerful angels. 8 He will punish those who do not know God and do not obey the gospel of our Lord Jesus.

2 THESSALONIANS 1:7b-10

⁹They will be punished with everlasting destruction and shut out from the presence of the Lord and from the glory of his might 10 on the day he comes to be glorified in his holy people and to be marveled at among all those who have believed.

If you erase hell from your Christian worldview, then you have eliminated your personal need for salvation through Christ.

¹⁷ Do not repay anyone evil for evil. Be careful to do what is right in the eyes of everyone. 18 If it is possible, as far as it depends on you, live at peace with everyone. 19 Do not take revenge, my dear friends, but leave room for God's wrath, for it is written:

ROMANS 12:17-20

"It is mine to avenge; I will repay," says the Lord. ²⁰ On the contrary: "If your enemy is hungry, feed him; if he is thirsty, give him something to drink. In doing this, you will heap burning coals on his head."

¹Therefore, since we are surrounded by such a great cloud of witnesses, let us throw off everything that hinders and the sin that so easily entangles.

HEBREWS 12:1-3

And let us run with perseverance the race marked out for us, ² fixing our eyes on Jesus, the pioneer and perfecter of faith. For the joy set before him he endured the cross, scorning its shame,

and sat down at the right hand of the throne of God. ³ Consider him who endured such opposition from sinners, so that you will not grow weary and lose heart.
